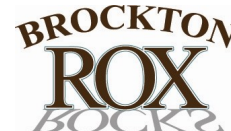

### TONIGHT'S ROX STARTER

LHP **Mike Wlodarczyk**, the Pitcher of the Week for June 14-20, will make his seventh start in a Brockton uniform and his sixth at Campanelli...he defeated New Jersey last Friday for his third straight win, allowing three runs on seven hits in six innings...June 20, he bested Worcester with seven innings of six-hit ball, allowing just one run with nine strikeouts...struck out 11 batters in his first outing on May 30...Wlodarczyk ranks first in strikeouts with 38...spent the past five years as a member of the Tampa Bay organization...reached Triple-A Durham in 2009, but played majority of time with Double-A Montgomery, amassing a 1-4 mark in 47 games with a 5.40 ERA...7th-round pick in 2005 by Tampa Bay out of Boston College...as a starter with Eagles in 2005, went 10-2 with a 2.96 ERA in 12 starts.

**TONIGHT'S MATCHUP:** Brockton (18-12) has dropped the first two games of an important four-game series with the Quebec Capitales (22-9) and now sit 3.5 games back of Quebec for first place in the Can-Am League. Including tonight, there are 17 games remaining in the first half of the season. The winner of the first half will receive the No. 1 seed and home-field advantage in the playoffs in September. The Rox are 1-4 against Quebec so far in the 2010 season and are 4-3 on the current eight-game homestand (took three of four from New Jersey). The next win for the Rox will be their 400th in team history. LHP **Mike Wlodarczyk** (4-1) will try to win his fourth consecutive game as he defeated New Jersey last Friday in Brockton, giving up three runs over six innings of work. The Can-Am League Pitcher of the Week for the week of June 14-20 has not yet faced Quebec this season. He leads the league in strikeouts (38) and is tied with several players (including two Rox hurlers) with four wins on the season. He will be opposed by former major leaguer LHP Troy Cate (NR). Cate will be making his first appearance with the Capitales after spending the majority of last year with the Long Island Ducks of the Atlantic League. He made one appearance in the Blue Jays system in 2009 with the Double-A New Hampshire FisherCats. Cate pitched in 14 games with the St. Louis Cardinals in 2007 and racked up a solid 3.38 ERA out of the pen in the National League. **YESTERDAY:** Quebec starter Matthew Rusch dealt seven scoreless innings and allowed just four hits as the Capitales shutout the Rox, 3-0, on Wednesday evening at Campanelli Stadium. The Capitales scored the only run they would need in the first inning. 2B Josh Colafemina led off the game with a walk, stole second base and then moved to third on SS Ivan Naccarata's groundout. CF Goefrey Tomlinson then brought him home with a sacrifice fly to right field. Quebec added single runs in the fourth, on a double-play ball that scored C Patrick D'Aoust, and in the sixth on a solo home run by RF Jared Lemieux. In seven innings, Rush only allowed two Rox base runners to reach second base and none to third. Brockton did not have multiple hits in any inning in the game and finished with just six for the contest for the second straight evening. SS **Dominic Ramos** accounted for two of the Rox hits and was the only man on the club to reach base twice. Rusch (4-0) joins Rox RHP **Freddy Flores** as the only pitchers in the league with 4-0 marks. Rusch struck out six and walked just one. Brockton starter **Buster Lussier** (1-2) took the defeat, but delivered a solid outing, going six innings and giving up three runs on seven hits. The Rox were closed out in the ninth inning by LHP Andrew Albers, who earned his third save of the season for the Capitales. Brockton's bullpen was strong in relief of Lussier, as LHP **Brad Hertzler** and RHP **Josh Papelbon** combined for three shutout innings, including a perfect ninth from Papelbon. Hertzler struck out three in his two full innings of work.

**ROX SWEEP WEEKLY AWARDS:** RHP **Freddy Flores** and 3B **Phillip Cuadrado** were named the Can-Am League Pitcher and Batter of the Week, respectively, for the week of June 21-27. Flores had two solid starts during the week, picking up the victory in both outings and improving his record to 4-0 on the season. He is the third consecutive Rox pitcher to receive the weekly league pitching award. Cuadrado had a monster week at the plate, going 10-for-20 with three home runs, nine RBI and a .583 on-base percentage.

**TEAM TOTALS:** The Rox are second in the league in batting average at .281, have scored the third-most runs (166/5.5 per game), have the second-best slugging percentage (.408), and have struck out the fewest times (171)...the pitching staff is first in the league with a 3.75 ERA and have walked the fewest batters (68), which is 36 fewer than any other club...the defense is tops in the league with a .980 fielding percentage and the fewest errors (23).

**BATTING LEADERS:** OF **Keith Brachold** leads the league with seven home runs and 15 extra-base hits, and is eighth in the league in batting average (.336)...3B **Phillip Cuadrado** leads the league with 24 walks, is tied for fifth with four homers...NF **Scott Wearne** is seventh in the league with a .349 average...C **Chris Grossman** is fifth in the Can-Am with 24 RBI.

**PITCHING LEADERS:** RHP **Mike Smith** leads the circuit with a 2.08 ERA and is second with 36 strikeouts...LHP **Mike Wlodarczyk**, RHP **Wayne Lundgren** and RHP **Freddy Flores** lead the Can-Am with four wins...Wlodarczyk also leads the league with 38 strikeouts while Lundgren is tops with 45.0 innings pitched...Flores is seventh with a 3.11 ERA and leads all qualified pitchers with just five walks...RHP **Buster Lussier** ranks ninth with his 3.41 ERA...RHP **Josh Papelbon** places third with six saves for the season.

**CLOSE LOSSES:** The Rox have lost their 12 games this season by a combined total of 29 runs (2.4 per game)...in the 18 games that the team has won, they have out-scored opponents by 73 runs (4.1 run margin per win) as they have a +44 run margin thus far in 2010...Brockton is 10-7 in games decided by two runs or less and 4-5 in one-run contests.
